

Membership Eligibility

- P1s, P2s, and P3s are all eligible to apply
- Must be in <u>good</u> academic standing
- Prospective inductees must comply with the PLS National Bylaws:
 - "...shall be actively involved in advancing the profession of pharmacy through demonstrated leadership in local, state, and national professional pharmacy organizations.
 - They shall possess a high degree of professionalism upon entrance to the society, as well as the capability to **maintain this professionalism** throughout their membership in the society."
