

The University of California Office of the President (UCOP) has purchased an insurance program to cover Registered Campus Organizations (RCOs) for most on-campus events. The university pays for the coverage, but RCOs are still responsible for making sure their on-campus event is registered with the insurance carrier and they receive the certificate of insurance when required.

The insurance carrier is **Mercer Health & Benefits Administration LLC**. Mercer is a wholly owned subsidiary of Marsh & McLennan Companies, which may be why you may hear someone refer to the company as Marsh.

**Waivers are required** for all sporting events and when minors are present regardless of hazard level class. Accident Medical is required for each player participant per sports season. An asterisk is noted next to sporting activities in the **Hazard Chart**.

## **OFF-CAMPUS EVENTS**

Off-campus events are not covered by University insurance. <u>Campus Connexions</u> offers off-campus event insurance if your RCO wishes to purchase it.
